CHECKLIST**

1. Scholarships are \$2,500.00 in value and are only available to graduating seniors currently enrolled in accredited Texas high schools.
2. Each scholarship will be issued in the form of a Certificate of Award by the Texas Elks State Association (TESA), conditioned upon the enrollment of the individual as a full-time student in an undergraduate four-year degree program at an accredited junior college, college, or university in the State of Texas within the calendar year the scholarship is awarded.
3. Enclose a sealed copy of your high school transcript.
4. Fill out **all** blanks on the application.
5. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the college/university the applicant will be attending after we receive proof of the applicant's enrollment. TESA will contact the winners to obtain the college information and student ID number.
6. Applicant may attach copies of awards and honors. Application is NOT to exceed a total of 20 pages
7. Applications should be enclosed in a clear plastic or three-ring folder or binder.
8. Applications will not be returned to applicants regardless of the outcome of the selection process.
9. **DEADLINE: Applications are due to the LOCAL LODGE by MARCH 15, 2010. No late applications will be accepted. Remember - BE PREPARED.**
10. If additional space is needed, please attach on a separate piece of paper.
11. Submit at least two (2) letters of recommendation with application from persons in the following areas: school, community, church or scouting.
12. Submit a copy of Eagle Scout certificate.

LODGE AND DISTRICT CHAIRPERSONS INSTRUCTIONS

1. Judging: Judge each application based upon the following criteria:
 - a. Financial need
 - b. Extra curricular events and leadership participation
 - c. Academics
2. Each lodge is to receive, judge, and submit the **top five (5) applicants** from their lodge to the **DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIP CHAIRPERSON** by **April 1, 2010**. The District Chairperson is to forward one (1) district winner to the State Chairperson by the posted deadline.
3. **DEADLINE: Applications are due to the STATE CHAIRPERSON no later than April 15, 2010.**

JUDGING GUIDELINES

1. Financial need:

A. \$0.00 to \$25,000	500 points
B. \$25,000 to \$50,000	400 points
C. \$50,000 to \$75,000	300 points
D. \$75,000 to \$100,000	200 points
E. \$100,000 +	100 points
2. Extracurricular activities: 100 points per activity **or** 200 points per activity if they are an officer in the activity.
