



TEXAS ELKS STATE ASSOCIATION 2010 GIRL SCOUT GOLD AWARD SCHOLARSHIP



AWARD The Texas Elks State Association awards a \$2,500 scholarship annually to one Texas graduating senior who has earned the Girl Scout Gold Award. The scholarship must be used at a Texas college, university or trade/vocational school during the June, 2010-May 2011 school year.

Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the institution the recipient attends, upon receipt of enrollment verification form from the school.

APPLICATION DEADLINE Application must be received by **THURSDAY, APRIL 15, 2010.**

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

ELIGIBILITY

- Be a 2010 graduating senior Girl Scout who needs financial assistance for post-secondary education expenses.
- Earn the Girl Scout Gold Award and provide proof of final approval of Gold Award project by May 1.
- Plan to attend a Texas college, university or trade/vocation school during 2010-2011 school year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Fill out **all** blanks on the TESA Gold Award Scholarship Application. Type or print legibly in **black** ink.
- In addition, submit the following information:
 - Sealed copy of high school transcript
 - Three (3) letters of recommendation. One recommendation should be from an adult Girl Scout who is not a relative. Other letters may be from school, church or community representatives.
 - Copy of Girl Scout Gold Award Final Report as submitted to your Girl Scout Council
(Application may be submitted prior to final Council approval, however confirmation of Council approval by May 1 will be required before scholarship is awarded)
- Enclose application and additional documents in a clear folder or 3-ring binder. Applications will not be returned to applicants regardless of the outcome of the selection process.

SELECTION PROCESS

A three-judge panel will evaluate applications on leadership, achievement, recommendations and financial need. Judges may award additional weight for an outstanding Gold Award Project.

If the Gold Award Final Report does not indicate your Council's final approval of your Project, confirmation that approval was received by May 1 will be required from your Council via email or fax in the form of a statement of approval or copy of your Gold Award Certificate, before the scholarship can be awarded.
